Remove the springs. 2. Separate into fabric, sponge, and springs. 3. Bring them to the Cleaning Center. *If you cannot do so, ask a specialized company to dispose of them.</p>							
	<p>Fluorescent tubes and Mercury-using products</p> <p>Fluorescent tubes Mercury thermometer Sphygmomanometers</p> <p>To prevent danger, please protect items from cracking. 1. Put them in the box they were purchased in. 2. Wrap them in a newspaper.</p>

Food waste
- Drain any liquid from food waste.
- Trees and branches must be within 5cm in diameter and 1m in length, and dry them before disposal.
- If metal is attached to items and cannot be removed, please dispose of them on a "non-combustible garbage day".

Small amount of trees & branches

How to dispose of grass from mowing

1. After drying, put them in the city designated bags.
2. Take out only **one bag** at a time.

Garbage Diet Project

In order to reduce combustible garbage, the city, citizens and businesses are working together on the "Garbage Diet Project".

Sorting clothes
Put clothes no longer needed in a clothes/leather collection box!
After collection, they will be exported to overseas for reuse.

Sorting used and miscellaneous paper
If you think "paper" at first glance, recycle them!
Take them out to your local waste collection or put them in a used paper collection box.

The 3 Actions Movement

- Drain all liquid** - Squeeze liquid well before disposing of garbage!
- Use all**
- Eat all** - "Fujinomiya 3010 Movement"

The 3rd Sunday of every month is "Fridge Clean-Up Day"!

Garbage cannot be collected	Unsorted Garbage	A rule violation sticker will be attached to the garbage bag. Please sort the garbage and dispose of it again. If you do not know how to sort garbage, please contact the Life Environment Division.
	Large amount of garbage	A Large amount of garbage at one time, such as when moving or cleaning house, etc., cannot be collected. Please contact the Cleaning Center in advance to confirm the date for carrying garbage in, or ask a general waste disposal company licensed by the city to dispose of it.
	Garbage from business operations (Industrial Wastes)	Garbage from business operations cannot be collected. (Items used for the same purpose in the past cannot be collected.) Industrial Wastes cannot be disposed of at the Cleaning Center. Please contact a specialized contractor.
	Garbage cannot be dispose of *Hazardous and toxic materials cannot be collected.	<p>Concrete Rubble, Earth, Debris</p> <p>Waste oil, Paints, Pesticides</p> <p>Machinery parts</p> <p>Construction waste</p> <p>Carbon Dioxide cartridges</p> <p>Fire extinguisher</p> <p>Batteries</p> <p>Portable batteries</p> <p>Products using chlorofluorocarbons</p> <p>Agricultural machines</p>

(Disassembled parts also cannot be collected.) A recycling fee will be charged for disposal.
